#### Day 01 ~ Friday ~ (March 07) Departing USA to Egypt

Check in at JFK International Airport to board the flight to Cairo, Egypt.

#### Day 02 ~ Saturday ~ (March 08) Arrival in Cairo - Cairo City - Giza Pyramids - Memphis - Saggara
