Day 3 SEPTEMBER 13, 2025 Breakfast/Dinner

Tour of *Soweto*. You will visit **Freedom Square** and stand on the only road in the world which carries the honor of two recipients of the Nobel Peace Prize - **Vilakazi Street**. Your tour of Soweto includes the awe-inspiring **Hector Pieterson Memorial**, **Orlando Children's Home**, an orphanage for abandoned, abused, and parentless children (from newborn to 16 years old).

Day 4 SEPTEMBER 14, 2025 Breakfast/Dinner PRETORIA

This morning you will board your coach for a <u>guided</u> tour of **Pretoria**. Here you will also see the world's largest statue of Nelson Mandela.

The coach will depart for *Lesedi Cultural Village*. After the dancing there will be a superb buffet dinner featuring British, American and African cuisine.

Day 5 SEPTEMBER 15, 2025 Breakfast/Dinner JOHANNESBURG / CAPE TOWN

08:45 AM

Depart for Cape Town. Arrive and tour the **Malay quarter and Signal Hill** (which overlooks Cape Town). Weather permitting, you will transfer to the cable car which whisks you to the top of **Table Mountain** (in 4 minutes). At the top of Table Mountain, you "can see forever" with a 360-degree view of all that the "Fairest Cape" has to offer.

Dinner

This morning you will depart on a tour of the *Cape Peninsula* along one of South Africa's most scenic and popular routes.

You will have a chance to join the MV "Circe" for a half-hour cruise to "Seal Island" or for the not so adventurous, the fish market "Mariners Wharf" is a must.

After your visit to Hout Bay, you will take a short ride to the famous *Groot Constantia Wine Farm.* Against a backdrop of the majestic Table Mountain, enjoy the renowned Chardonnays, Blancs and Steins of the sought-after Cape Winelands - not to mention the rich, full-bodied Cabernets and Shiraz's.

The tour now continues South, following the Atlantic Ocean until you reach *Cape Point* and the Cape of Good Hope.

After lunch you will return along the Indian Ocean, through the naval base of Simons' Town where you will visit The **Boulders Penguin colony** before driving through Fish Hoek and the mountains and then arriving back to Cape Town.

This morning you will board your coach and take a short drive to *Green Market Square*. A produce market since 1806, it is now a colorful open-air flea market area with many stalls and vendors selling arts and crafts of many kinds. You will spend about 1½ hours at the market, and there are several cafes and coffee shops surrounding the market.

From Green market Square you will transfer to the *Victoria & Alfred Waterfront* (V & A) for some more shopping time as well as lunch *(on your own account)* at one of the many restaurants available.

After lunch you will proceed to for your boat ride to **Robben Island.** You will be taken on a <u>guided</u> tour of the island by one of the previous inmates as your guide and you will be shown the prison and Nelson Mandela's home, for 18 years.

The boat will return you to the V&A where you will have a short time to wander around the many shops before being transferred to a restaurant where you will enjoy their "communal feast". Serving food that celebrates Africa's diversity and rich tapestry of tastes and aromas.
